Dear Brothers,

Fraternal Greetings to you all.

- 1. 5TH PROVINCIAL CHAPTER:** Most of the Brothers and communities went through the 31ST General Chapter document seriously and have sent in their reflections. The chapter Preparatory Committee consisting of Bro. Ignatius, Bro. Prabhu and Bro. Jenny Kuriakose have already synthesised the reflections received from communities and individuals. The sharing and reflections gathered from the three Sector meetings will also be incorporated into these synthesis. This will become part of the fifth Provincial Chapter documents. As per the existing guidelines, the composition of the next Provincial Chapter will be as follows.

Elected Members:

- With Perpetual Vows: $\frac{66}{4} = 16.5 = 17$
- With temporary Vows: $\frac{12}{4} = 3$

Ex– Officio Members: Members of the Provincial administration: **5+1+1**

South Pacific District Superior : 1

Co–Opted Members: (If any)

Bro. John Kalarackal, the Asst. General in charge of our Province also will participate in our Chapter.

- 2. ELECTION OF THE CAPITULANTS:** As per the decisions of our 1st Provincial Chapter, the Brothers with perpetual Vows, including the ex-officio members will elect one member for every four Brothers with perpetual vows. The Brothers with temporary vows will elect from among themselves one Brother for every four Brothers or less (1st Provincial Chapter, No. 6.2.7). The ballot papers for the election of the capitulants are enclosed herewith. I kindly request each of you to participate in the election process in a very responsible manner, with prayer and reflection.
The ballot papers for the Brothers with perpetual vows are **white** in colour, while the ballot papers for the Brothers with temporary vows are **pink**.
- 3. ELECTION PROCEDURE:** All the members of the community assemble at a pre-determined time and place on the day fixed for the election procedure. Each Brother exercises his vote after sufficient prayer and reflection and in absolute privacy. The Brothers with perpetual vows will underline seventeen (17) or less names while the Brothers with temporary vows will underline three (3) or less names. The ballot papers are then placed in an envelope in the presence of all the members of the community and sealed with the following inscription written on the cover: "This envelope contains the votes of Bros....(names of the Brothers)". The eldest and the youngest members of the community affix their signature on the sealed envelope and that envelope is placed in another envelope addressed to the *E. Secretary, St. Louis Villa, Post Box No. 6, Yercaud – 636601, Salem Dt. Tamil Nadu.* This cover is sent by speed post or courier, so as to reach St. Louis Villa before 5th August, 2011. In the case of a Brother living alone, the same procedure is to be followed. He writes the above inscription on the sealed envelope containing his vote and puts his signature. This envelope is then placed in another envelope addressed to the *E. Secretary, St. Louis Villa, Post Box No. 6, Yercaud – 636601, Salem Dt. Tamil Nadu* and the same is sent to St. Louis Villa by speed post or courier.
- 4. REVISION OF SALARY / D.A:** The Provincial administration is working on the revision of salary and other benefits to our Private Staff and Domestic Employees. The 'Finance Commission' is asked to give its proposals regarding this matter at the earliest to the Administration. Meanwhile, all the communities and Institutions are requested to continue with the existing salary scale and D.A. until the new scale is announced. All the members of Staff and Domestic employees will be paid with retrospective effect from the month of June 2011, the differences (if any).
